PROFILE

29.07.1979: Passed Acharya (Sahitya) from Kendriya Sanskrit Vidya Pitham, Tirupati Under Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi in 1st class and got admitted to G.N.Jha Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapith, Allahabad as a Research Scholar for Ph.D. Degree.

20.08.1979: Soon after appointed as a Classical (Sanskrit) Teacher in Govt. Girls' High School, Patnagarh, Odisha, Pandit Sadananda Dikshita initiated the life Mission through 2 Samskruta Sambhashana Sangosthis among school students to study and practise Spoken Sanskrit .

17.10.1979: Started unique publication of Sanskrit monthly LOKABHASHA in Odia Script from Bhadrak and production from Patnagarh with a concept : "LOKABHASHA HI SAMSKRUTAM".

25.03.1980: Organized Sanskrit Conference in Patnagarh and a great Sanskrit scholar cum Administrator Sri S.Sundar Rajan IAS, the then R.D.C Odisha, (North Zone) graced the event as the Chief Guest. Special issue of Lokabhasha was released by Sri S.Sundara Rajan.

01.05.1980: A bicycle tour all over of Odisha state with the divine message LOKABHASHA HI SAMSKRUTAM and met a good number of Sanskrit Scholars from 01.05.1980 to 14.06.1980 .

1980: Sri S. Sundar Rajan IAS, R.D.C. Sambalpur released the special issue of LOKABHASHA being published from Patnagarh at the Sanskrit conference in Patnagarh.

30.09.1981: Resigned from the Government Teachership on 30.09.1981 and went to Bangalore to work vigorously with all time friend **Chamu Krishna Shastry** as a volunteer at Hindu Seva Pratisthanam (Sanskrit Vibhaga) under the guidance of Pujya Swami Vishvesha Tirtha, the most honorable monk of our country.

02.10.1981: Worked as a Samskruta Sevavratī, conducted Samskruta Sambhashana Siviram, Samskruta Prashikshana Siviram organized Sanskrit Conference, Workshops and all other Sanskrit promotion Schemes till 05.05.1982.

05.05.1982 to 01.11.1982 : Left Bangalore on 05.05.1982 and joined Viswa Samskruta Pratisthanam, Pondicherry as the honorary National Coordinator. Coordinated a truly national level Sanskrit Training camp for Sanskrit Teachers from almost every state of Bharat in Pondicherry with a view to creating a band of a state level nucleus of Spoken Sanskrit Instructors.

02.11.1982: Joined the post of Research Asistant (temporarily) in Shri Sadasiva Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapitham in Puri (Odisha) on 02.11.1982 to 01.02.1983.

02.02.1983 - Joined as the Lecturer in Sri Jagannatha Vedakarmakanda Mahavidyalaya, PURI on 02.02.1983 and worked there till 30.06.2007. Took Voluntary retirement on 30.06.2007 as a Senior Lecturer.

13.03.1983- Founded LOKABHASHA PRACHARA SAMITI in PURI on 13.03.1983 with an aim to promote and propagate Spoken Sanskrit through Ten point programmes. Renowned elites of Puri Prof. Satyabadi Mishra, Sri Harihar Bahinipati, ex-deputy speaker and Prof. Haranath Mishra, Advocate Purnachandra Mahapatra were present.

Compiled and published a hand book on Spoken Sanskrit – Samskruta-Sambhashanam and patriotic Sanskrit songs – Madhura Samskrutam.

09.06.1983 – Sri Ranganath Mishra, Hon'ble Justice, Supreme court of Bharat inaugurated Lokabhasha Prachara Samiti in Puri on 09.06.1983 in the presence of Prof. Satyavadi Mishra, Padmashri Sadashiva Rathasharma and Dr. Sraddhakar Supakar . Conducted the dais as the President of Lokabhasha Prachara Samiti and successfully committed to further LOKABHASHA movement.

08.10.1983 – Conducted first Sanskrit Instructor's Training Camp (Residential) in Damodar Sanskrit Vidyalaya, Bhadrak for 05 days from 08.10.1983 to 12.10.1983. 15 Students participated and successfully committed to further LOKABHASHA movement.

25.12.1983: Conducted Second Training Camp from 25.12.1983 to 29.12.1983 in Sri Jagannath Vedakarmakanda Mahavidyalaya, Puri. 30 students participated and successfully committed to further LOKABHASHA movement.

29.12.1983: "Lokabhasha Hi Samskrutam" a nice compilation of various Sanskrit related articles was released by Sri Lokanath Saha.

02.02.1984 – Lokabhasha Prachara Samiti was registered under 1860 Act and the President Sadananda Dikshita opted to be the General Secretary and held the post till 13.03.2018.

04.06.1984: Organized Sanskrit conference in Katak and Dr. Radhanath Rath, Editor the Samaja, Sri Bichitrananda kar, Editor the Matrubhumi, Prof. Shriramchandra Dash and Padmashree Sadasiva Rathasharma graced the occasion.

04.06.1984 – Published modern Sanskrit Novel – Sitala Trushna by Dr. Keshab Chandra Dash and was released by Sheikh Matlub Ali, Ex Education Minister and Odisha.

27.12.1984: Conducted a full-fledged spoken Sanskrit camp among 300 students of Sukhalata Memorial Girls High School, Puri and Sri Gangar Mahapatra, Education Minister, Smt Ila Panda, Renowned Industrialist of the state graced the occasion.

13.03.1985: Organized 2nd anniversary of Lokabhasha Prachara Samitih in Puri. Sir Amar Sing IAS(R) and Prof. B.K. Mahanty, V.C of S.J.S.V. Visva Vidyalaya, Puri graced the occasion and released the Kishori Mohan Dwivedi commemoration Souvenir.

28.04.1985: Conducted Spoken Sanskrit camp among M.A. students of Utkal University from 19.04. to 28.04.1985. Prof. K.C. Acharya, H.OD, Dr. Sadasiva Praharaj, Dr. Alekh Chandra Sarangi, Radha Madhab Dash and Pracharaka Amulya Pradhan were present.

19.06.1985: Welcome address in the 1st All Odisha Sanskrit Conference at Soochana Bhavan, Bhubaneswar. Chief Minister of Odisha Sri J.B. Patnaik, Dr. Harekrushna Mahatab, Education Minister Sri Jadunath Dash Mahapatra and Soumyaranjan Patnaik, Editor: Sambad graced the occasion.

19.06.1985: Organized 1st all Odisha Sanskrit Conference in Bhubaneswar. Odisha's most veteran leader Dr. Harekrushna Mahatab, Chief Minister Sri Janaki Ballav Patnayak, Education Minister Sri Jadunath Dashmahapatra, Sri Soumyaranjan Patnayak, Editor Sambada (Odiya Daily) and Prof. B.K. Mohanty, V.C, Sri Jagannath Sanskrit Visvavidyalaya graced the occasion. Hundreds of Sanskrit scholars participated.

1986: Organized Sanskrit teachers' protest rally and students' congregation in different places of Odisha against the decision of Govt. of Bharat and Odisha to stop teaching of Sanskrit in School curriculum.

15.06.1987 – 10.07.1987: Organized a massive Spoken Sanskrit Teaching programme at Maharshi Vedavijnana Viswa Vidyapitham in Nodia, Delhi. 65 Sanskrit Prashikshakas conducted 200 classes among 5000 students successfully.

08.07.1987: (Photo) An exclusive interview published in Times of India, New Delhi.

19.07.1987: Prayed Shri Rajiv Gandhi, Prime minister of Bharat for restoration of Sanskrit education in Bharat,

1987: Met Sri P.V. Narasimha Rao. Education Minister of Bharat and again Sri K.C. Panth Education Minister and appealed for restoration of Sanskrit studies In school curriculum.

1987 Initiated a massive movement in Delhi, Bhubaneswar and Cuttack for restoration of Sanskrit education. Protective movements were organized regularly.
